Important notes:

- 1. Clothing items, including hats, with graphic designs or words relating to drugs, alcohol, tobacco, or anything else that can be smoked or inhaled, or with inappropriate language or with reference to inappropriate behavior are not allowed.
- 2. Dressing modestly is important. Cleavage, bellybuttons, and butt cheeks must be covered (meaning not exposed).
 - No thongs or cheekys allowed for bathing suits.
 - Shorts must cover butt cheeks.
 - No crop tops, camis, or halter tops on the trip.
 - Only T-shirts are allowed during the day.
 - Tank tops are okay in the evening if we are not visiting a holy site.
